Match Dates: June 30 (Saturday, Standard Rifle) & July 1 (Sunday, Hunting Rifle), 2012

Starting Times: Practice at ≈ 9:00, 1st Match at ≈ 10:30 each day

Course of Fire: There will be two 40 shot matches each day with a short break between matches.

Eligibility: Participants must be members of the Michigan Rifle & Pistol Association (applications available) or their home state association.

Rules: Current NRA Silhouette rules will apply.
DSC Rifle Range Rules will apply

Classification: The NRA classifications will be used. 2012 NRA scorebooks will be available and will be required to compete. Local classification books may be honored at the discretion of the Match Director, for classification purposes only.

Registration: These are squadded matches. Pre-registration is recommended, but not required. Squadding requests will be honored on a first come, first served basis. Late entries will be accepted only if they do not require special squadding or additional relays. Entries will close at 9:30 each day.

Entry Fees: \$35.00 per competitor. Second rifle: \$15.00

Awards: Awards will be based on the 80 shot aggregate scores. Awards will be for Match Winner and first in each class; however, if fewer than 5 entries in Master class, they will compete for Match Winner only. Additional class awards will be based on one award per 5 entries (i.e. 10 entries = 2 awards). Other awards may be presented per Match Director's bulletin based on pre-registration entries.
